80% of innovations fail despite urgent needs in health. Product development and adoption are critical pain points for many innovators

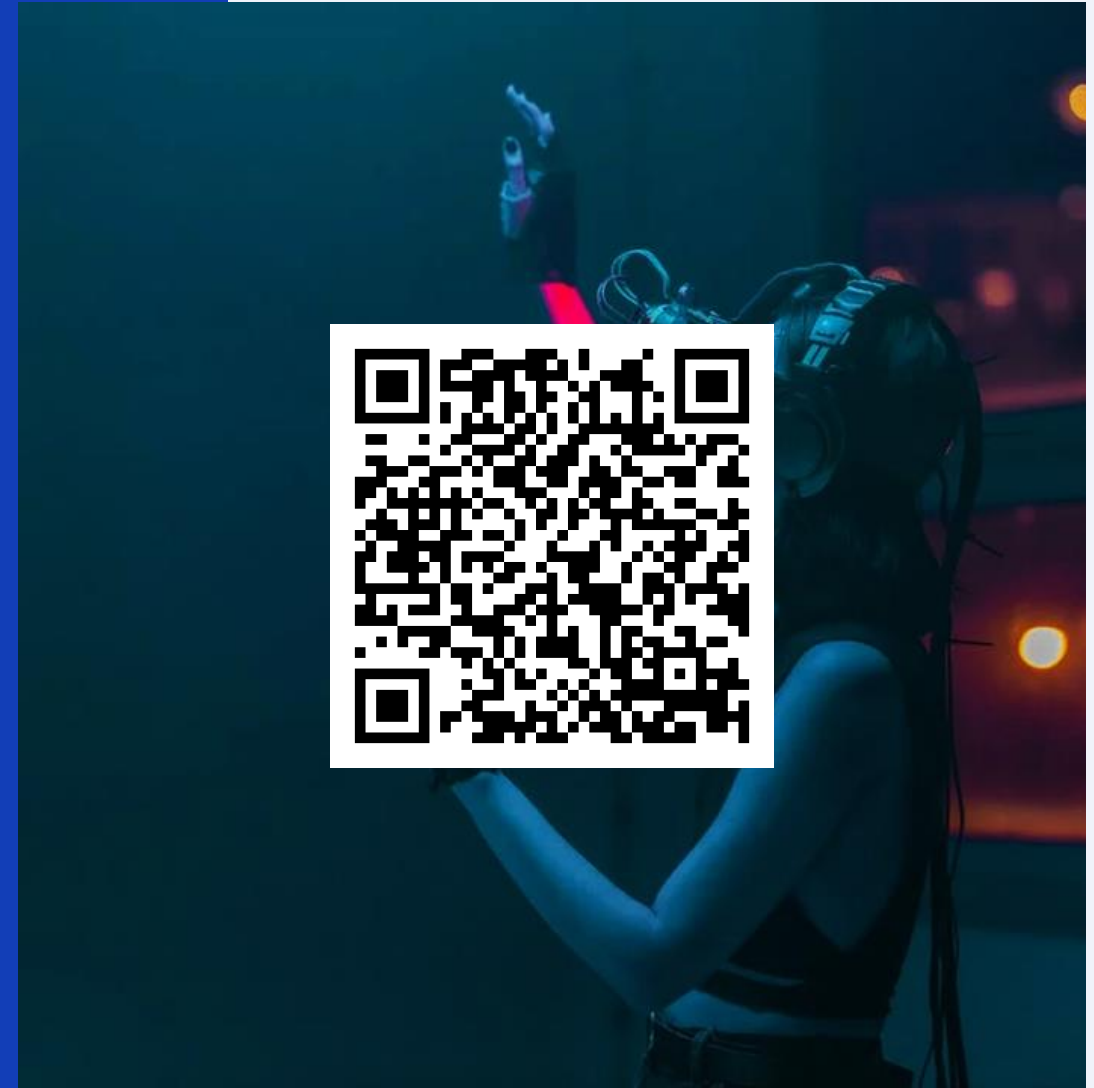
**MISSION**

- iii. Establishing strategic partnerships with end-users, regulators and funders in healthcare



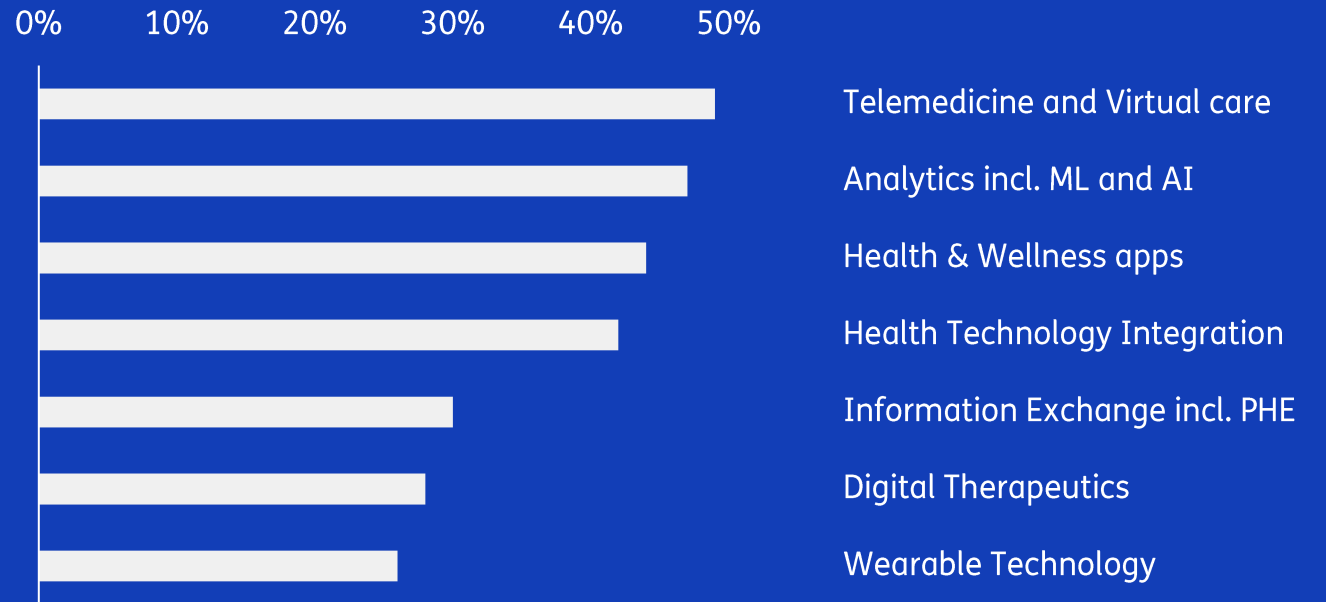

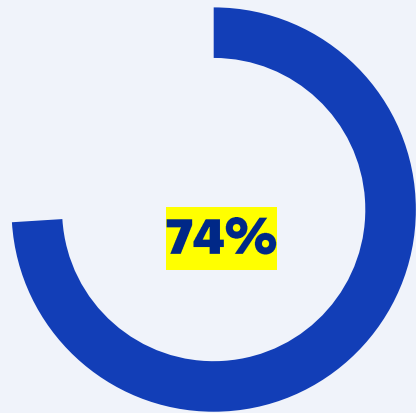

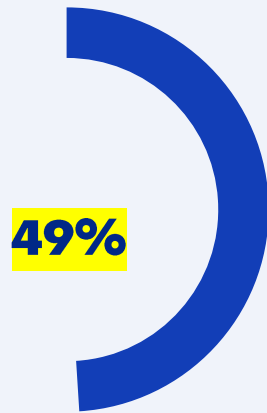


# SMEs in Digital Health often face common challenges

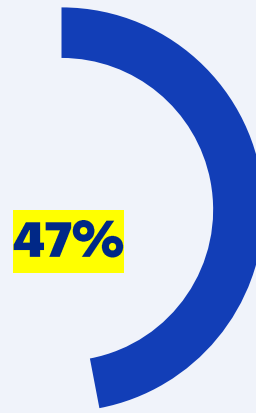
In what areas does your organization face R&D challenges?



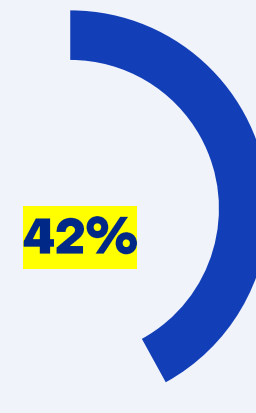
1. Integration in healthcare systems (including funding)



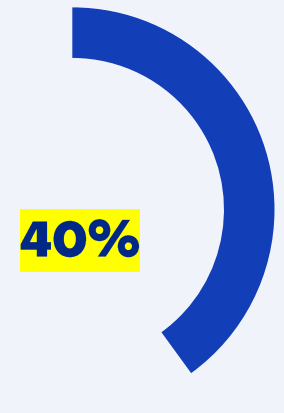
2. User adoption and engagement

*“Integration with established healthcare systems - they are very protective and not easy to connect to, unless you have a large customer. This makes innovation extremely difficult. Also the **Privacy discussion** is always an issue - it's not always clear what is included or excluded. A basic checklist would be nice.”*

*“Health care systems are currently not developed in such a way that you can easily **use data for AI**. Next to that it is very difficult to introduce new business models in the healthcare market. The Dutch market is very conservative. **Our healthcare system is focused on cure, not on prevention.**”*

# Yet, solving these challenges remains difficult and leads to loss of value

How does your organization currently address these challenges?

## Integration in healthcare systems

*“We think we have a potential game changer at hand. But we see that health care professionals are not eager to adopt innovations although it might reduce their workload. There is no potential incentive for them to do so because health care insurance companies often respond with their wallet and introduce lower budgets.”*

*New emerging technologies are adopted by the Dutch healthcare system for the pilot phase, but hardly anyone takes them further to market adoption.*

## Dealing with regulations

*“Investigate regulations and ask other companies for advice/insight for the technology in development. Which is time consuming”*

*“Reaching out to colleges and universities for data and spending a lot of time and resources to make sure our company isn't a medical device”*

## User adoption and engagement

*“For engagement, we are looking customized customer journeys and other products offered on our platform.”*

*“Trial and error...”*

## Evidence generation

*“Working with B2B clients who are in a less 'controlled' environment (no scientific evidence needed)”*

*“Collaboration with research organizations such as UvA, VU and others. Communicating with practitioners through other channels.”*

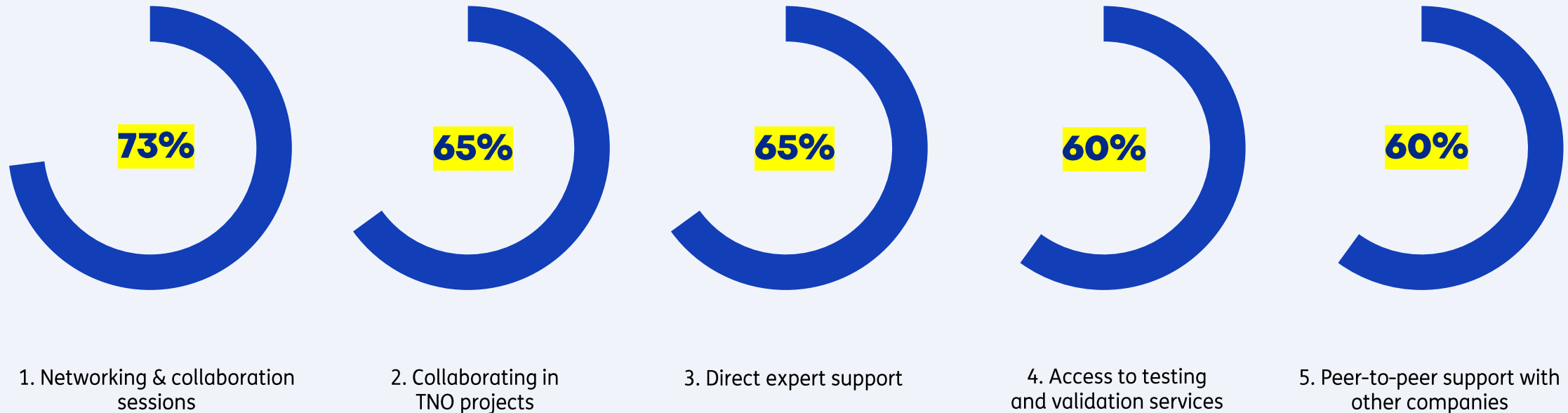
## Interoperability and data exchange

*“Much manual work in data integration and control. Releasing not fully finished open source software.”*

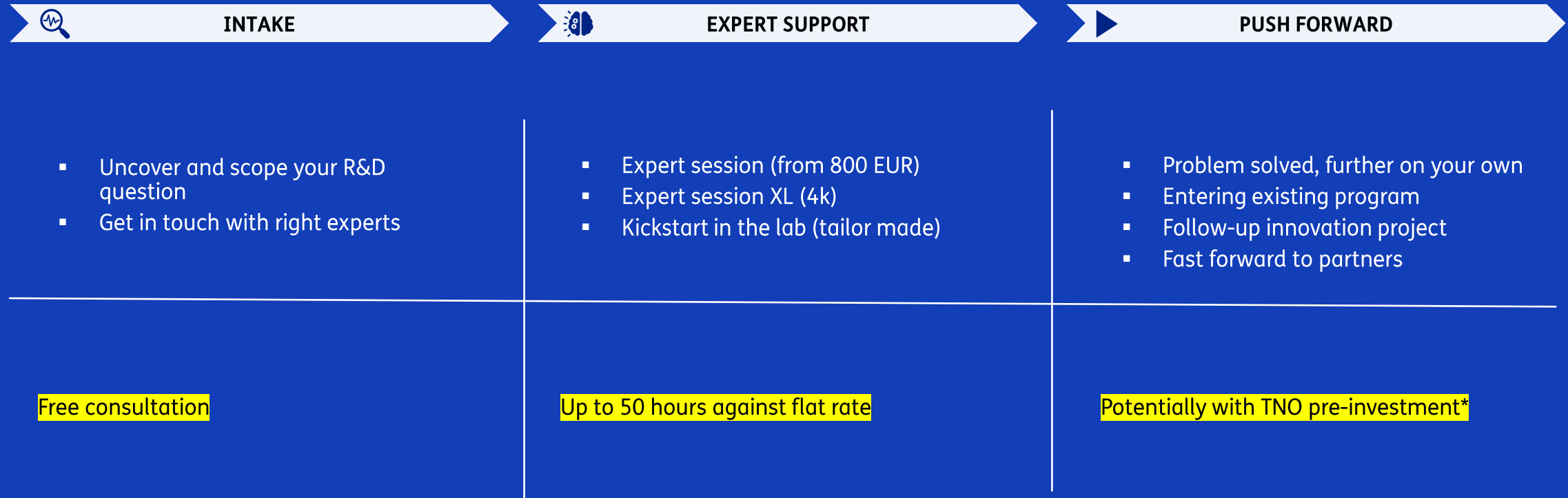

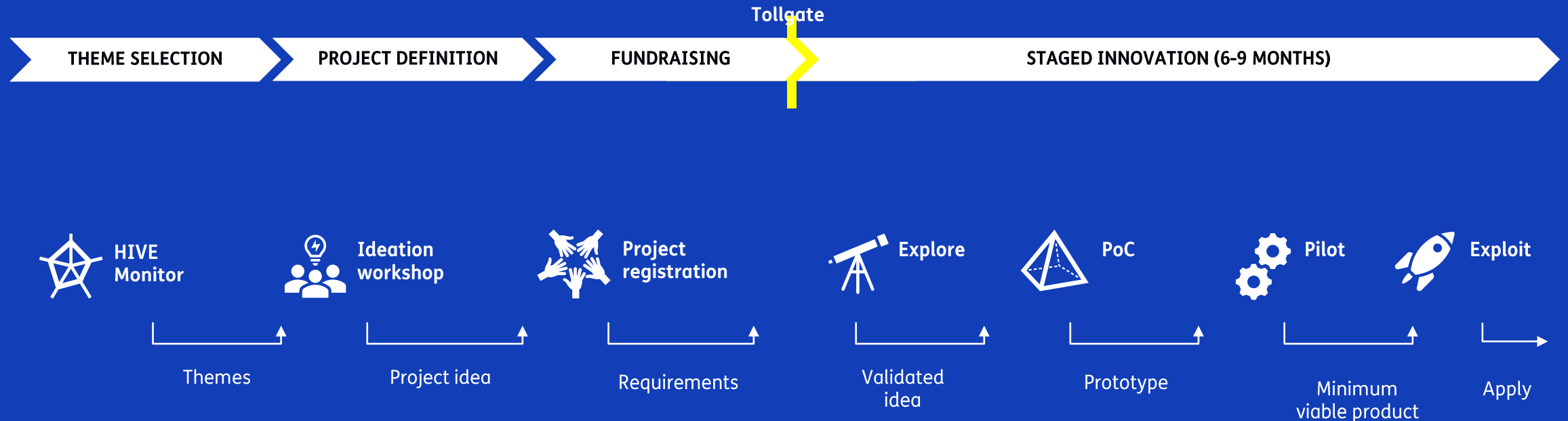

# Co-development: tackling shared challenges with peers



## Way of working

1. The HIVE annually selects leading themes in the area of Digital Health to work on. A community survey facilitates this process.

2. Project ideas are generated from these themes in collaborative ideation sessions.

3. SMEs register for project participation and fundraising starts. For selected projects, TNO can match the project fund if conditions are met.

4. Project are developed using staged innovation, moving from idea to exploitation.
